The St. Nicholas Church, which was destroyed in the terrorist attacks of 9/11, is currently under construction as the St. Nicholas National Shrine. The original building was built in 1832 and in 1916, Greek American immigrants started the congregation before moving to Cedar St where they purchased the building and converted it into a church in 1922. The building was completely buried by the collapse of the South Tower of the World Trade Center with very few religious items recovered.

The scholarship program offers scholarships to a wide variety of students. Recipients are: traditional and non-traditional students; seminarians, high school seniors, college and post-graduate students. Today, AHEPA remains firmly committed to promote the ancient Hellenic ideals of education.
